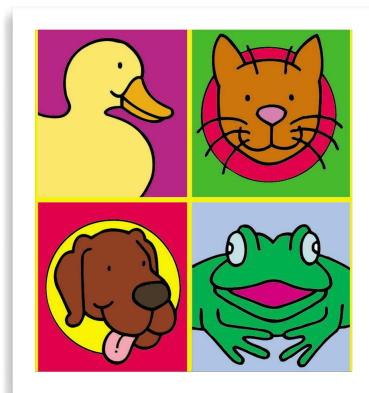

A baby deer is a little fawn, a baby fox is a little cub

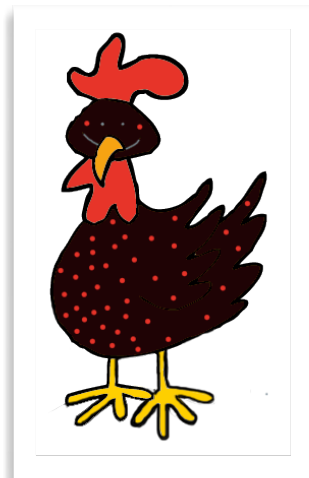
